For their 2nd album "In The Woods" no efforts were spared with the band maltreating themselves and their slim piggybanks making the production anything but a walk in the park. Their enthusiastically received showcase at Berlin's Popkomm in September finally proved it was worth all the trouble, leaving behind plenty of smiling faces and charmed ears. The hymnic chorus of the radiosingle AMNESIACS keeps insisting "It's gonna be a great great deal for all of us" and indeed the band drew attention hardly known to bands from Austria. After their rather playful debut "We Are Jealous. We Are Glass" in 2008 their second coming became a collection of great, pure indie-pop songs, with more bombast and integrity. Francis International Airport became skillfull studio-geeks obsessed with all the details of arrangement and production, whilst still preserving their love for catchy tunes with melancholic ambience and cunningly utilising the former to achieve the latter.
